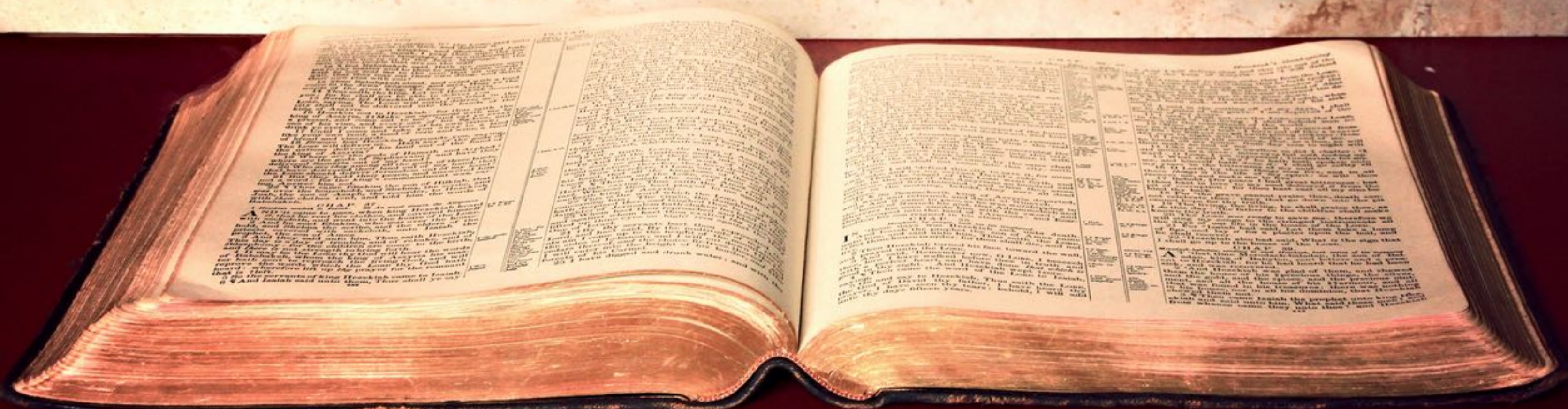


# Walking in the WORD
